Grey Literature for Clinical Evidence – April 8, 3 CEUs

Gaelen Adam is a librarian, editor, and research associate at [Brown University's Center for Evidence-based Medicine](#). Among her roles are designing and running grey literature searches for every project undertaken by the Center.
